- BE A RESPONSIBLE, ENGAGED, AND COMMUNICATIVE STUDENT

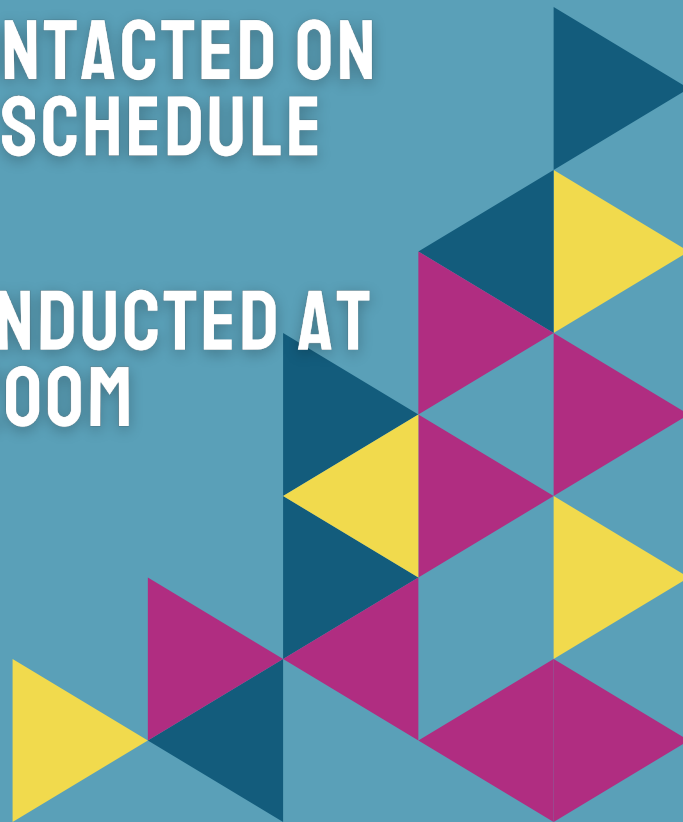


HOW TO APPLY?
